Château Labadie 2020: Complex and refined Bordeaux blend

Deep dark red color, with purple highlights. Its nose is powerful and deep, with empyreumatic and red fruit notes.

Its mouth is intense and rich, with a beautiful sweetness and a tannic structure highlighted by the general roundness.

Labadie is the birthplace of my family and our history. We still have a winery and vines there today. This vintage represents the passion of several generations and the authenticity of the beautiful Bordeaux terroirs, which are sometimes known, sometimes less...

Château Laroche Joubert 2020: Merlot in balance

The color is clear and shiny. The elegant nose with a delicately woody, spicy and vanilla bouquet, which when stirred opens up with notes of fresh fruit.

The palate is fresh with round and melted tannins.

This cuvée with a large predominance of Merlot is a Côtes de Bourg to be enjoyed at any time. Its suppleness and fruitiness make it accessible to all palates, with or without accompaniment.

Because Bordeaux must remain accessible!

Cuvée Gabin 2021: The freshness of Malbec

With a purplish color, the nose of this wine combines aromas of small red fruits such as redcurrant, with more spicy notes.

The gentle extraction process lets the crunch of the fruit express itself, giving a supple and refreshing taste.

Here we break the codes: a single varietal Malbec 100% fruit 0% extraction, a nice juicy and pleasant aperitif wine. Summer red wine to be served chilled, it is nonetheless a true AOC Côtes de Bourg.


