Domaine de l'Amauve is a small family estate of 12 hectares.

Christian Voeux is the main player in vineyard management, winemaking and marketing.

An oenologist by training, his experience of 45 years of winemaking and management of renowned vineyards in Châteauneuf du Pape helps in the production of remarkable wines.

The work is artisanal on the estate. The grapes are selected manually from the vine in May, June, and July. Then harvested manually.

The wines come from low-yielding vines and are made in a simple, natural and traditional way.

The estate is organic certified, HVE (High Environmental Value) certified, the red wines are VEGAN certified.

The wines produced are in AOC Côtes du Rhône Villages Séguret (White, Rosé, and Red) and in Vaucluse I.G.P. (Rosé and Red for the moment, a white wine will be added in 2024).
